1 Scope

This Bosch-Norm specifies the lettering of products and parts with the supplier code. The definition can be found in the Bosch-Norm N10A 1050-5, access to the values via:

2 General

- ▶ Products
- ▶ Assemblies
- ▶ Spare parts
- ▶ Very important components (also raw parts) manufactured by several suppliers

which are purchased from suppliers and licensees are marked with the supplier code number.
The supplier code is not applied to unimportant components and small parts.
The supplier code is not applied either when suppliers or licensees are allowed by contract to apply their own identification.

3 Design

The supplier code is shown in a rectangle, in the case of small cast or plastic injection molded parts it is only underlined.



3.1 Applying the supplier code

The supplier code is applied

- ▶ with characters of at least 2 mm
- ▶ close to the other lettering
- ▶ with space to the part number and other information in order to prevent confusion
- ▶ not on the name plate

The TEF-department checks the drawings, which are to be sent to the suppliers for the supplier code number and adds it if it has not been specified.
The proper lettering is monitored by the responsible QMM-department.

3.2 Specification on the production drawing

Location, size and type (e.g. underlined) of the supplier code on products are marked on the production drawing with a sectioned field.

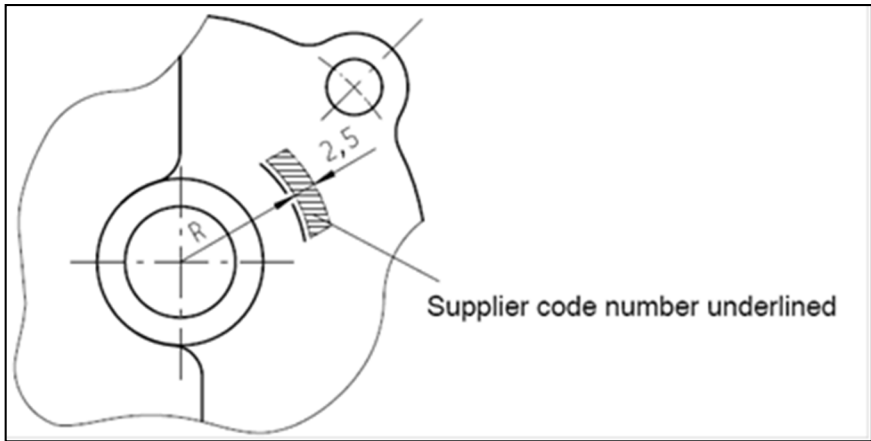


Figure 2 Specification on the production drawing, example
